## WE ARE THE INDEPENDENTS SCHOLARSHIP SWEEPSTAKES Official Rules

- 1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. The "We are the Independents Scholarship Sweepstakes" (the "Sweepstakes") is available July 1, 2019, through March 31, 2020 (the "Sweepstakes Period"). To enter, visit www.wearetheindependents.com during the Sweepstakes Period and enter your email address, and complete the online entry form. Entrants may receive additional entries by, during the Sweepstakes Period, going on a campus visit at any Sponsor member institution, taking a "selfie" on campus, and posting the selfie to Twitter using the WeAretheIndependents hash tag. Only one name and entry per member institution campus visit is allowed. To earn additional entries without visiting a member institution campus, entrants may submit a short statement (200 characters or less) telling us why you are interested in (name of college or university) and include two factors about the campus that influenced your interest. Statements may be sent to mlevey@michigancolleges.org. There is a limit of fifteen (15) total entries allowed per person. All entries become the property of Sponsor.
- 2. **Eligibility.** Open only to students enrolled as juniors or seniors in high school, who are legal residents of the state of Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, or Illinois. Void where prohibited, taxed, licensed, or restricted by law. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.
- 3. **Drawing.** On or about March 31, 2020, Sponsor will hold a random drawing to select eight winners from among all qualifying entries received during the Sweepstakes Period. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. Many will enter, few will win.
- 4. **Prizes.** Winners will each receive a certificate for a \$2,000 scholarship which may be used at one of Sponsor's member institutions (approximate total retail value of \$2,000). IN NO EVENT SHALL THE RELEASED PARTIES' TOTAL LIABILITY TO YOU FOR ALL DAMAGES, LOSSES, OR CAUSES OF ACTION EXCEED THE PRIZE VALUE. MICHIGAN WITHOUT REGARD TO ITS CONFLICTS OF LAWS RULES. The parties irrevocably submit and consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts located in, or closest to, Kent County, Michigan. The parties agree not to raise the defense of forum non conveniens.
